## Garden Named Charity Partner for 2004 Southern Living Idea House

The State Botanical Garden has been selected as the charity partner for the 2004 *Southern Living* Idea House being built at the Georgia Club near Athens. The Idea House program was created by *Southern Living* as a showcase for the latest trends in the building industry and home interiors and is one of the magazine's most popular programs. Two other houses are being built in San Antonio, Texas, and near Panama City, Florida.

The three-level, 6,400 square foot house was designed by Caldwell-Cline Architects. Beautifully sited overlooking the 16<sup>th</sup> green, the house encompasses a main floor living area, upper level with bedrooms and bonus room, and lower level complete with exercise room and home-theater. Terraces, decks and attractive landscape will enhance the outdoor living space. The house is being built by Athens-based Greene & Johnson with interior design by H&L Design Group. Landscape architect Cheryl Mihalko has designed the garden.

The Georgia Club is a 1,200-acre community of planned neighborhoods located just off highway 316 a few minutes west of Athens and less than an hour from Atlanta. The Georgia Club has been planned to ensure architectural integrity, enhance quality of life and
